About SNAP Employment & Training (E&T)

The purpose of SNAP E&T is to help support individuals receiving SNAP benefits obtain employment through voluntary participation. These supports include job search, education and training activities that promote self-sufficiency with support including clothing, equipment, transportation, and other job-related fees. Tuition assistance may be available through referrals to education and training partners.



Work Readiness

Training on fundamental soft skills necessary in the workforce including workplace relationships, communication, work ethic, and personal presentation



Supervised Job Search

Coaching sessions with a career planner including review of activities, resume building, and identifying potential job opportunities



Job Retention

Guidance, counseling and other transitional supports once employment, a registered apprenticeship, or other on-the-job training program is secured
