

# Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC)

## What is a CCBHC?

CCBHCs are outpatient clinics that provide a wide range of mental health and substance use services. They are open to everyone, no matter their age, diagnosis, insurance coverage or where they live.

## What services does a CCBHC provide?

CCBHCs must offer or help connect people to a basic set of important services, including:

- Crisis support for mental health, like 24/7 mobile crisis teams, help during emergencies, and short-term care to stabilize a crisis.
- Ongoing mental health and substance use treatment using proven, effective methods.
- Basic health checks and monitoring of important health signs at the clinic.
- Help coordinating care between different doctors and services.
- Support from people who have lived experience with mental health or substance use disorders, including support for families and recovery coaching.
- Specialized mental health care in the community for veterans and active-duty military members.

## Why CCBHCs?

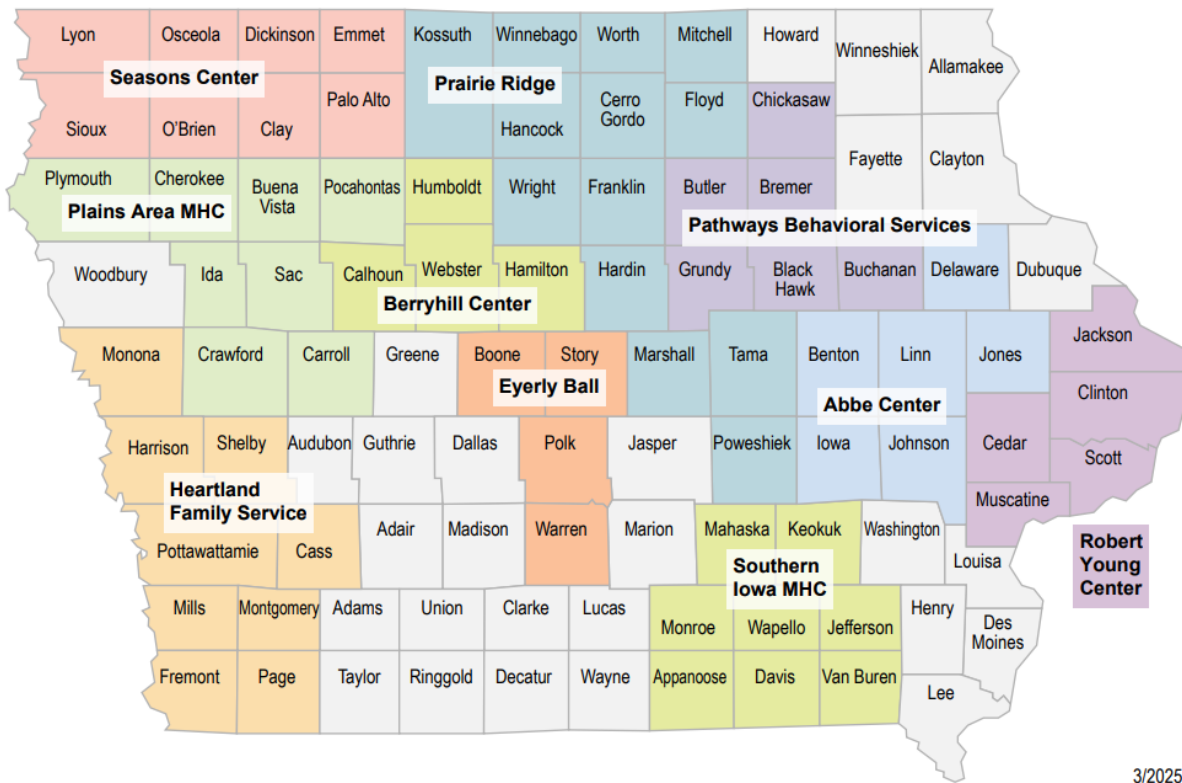
- **For Iowans:**  
You get fast access to high-quality, whole-person care that's based on data and proven methods. Services are well-coordinated and focused on your individual needs.
- **For Providers:**  
When providers meet over 113 CCBHC standards, they qualify for a special payment system that reimburses them based on the actual cost of care.
- **For Iowa:**  
The state builds a strong network of top-performing mental health and substance use disorder providers that work closely with healthcare and social services. This leads to better results for patients and lower overall costs. Being part of the

federal demonstration program also means Iowa can receive more federal funding for these services.
